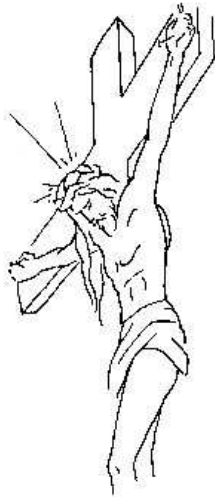


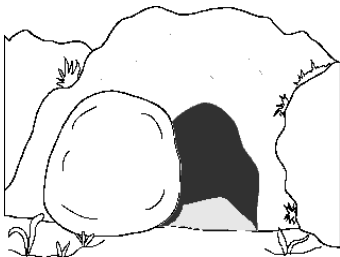
The Easter Story

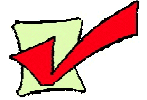


Something to think about
